ABSTRACT:

Thorough debridement is required for the whole root canal system for successful endodontic therapy. One factor contributing to inadequate canal cleaning may be the complex root canal architecture.

The mandibular molars exhibit significant differences in terms of additional roots or canals. With the use of any magnification devices, the clinician should strive to locate every potential channel. The middle mesial canal changes in mandibular molars are covered in this report.
